


YELLOW SCHOOL

He handed out invitations to each of his friends before gobbling down his jam on toast.





He felt terrible.


Sonny's mummy was really worried. She wanted to take Sonny to A&E but Sonny's daddy had the car. Maybe clever Auntie Amber could help...



"Meow!"

“Mummy, mummy, what about all my friends?”


... said Sonny the following morning.

for the big party tomorrow.




It was Saturday and everyone was round Sonny's house to celebrate his birthday.

“STOP! We haven’t washed our hands and we don’t want to get ill again”.


So Sonny waited by the sink to make sure everyone cleaned their hands properly using soap and water.
